

A reenactment of the Missouri Legislature passing the Ordinance of Secession was held on Saturday 29 October 2011 at the Courthouse on the square in Cassville, Missouri. It was an event that was well-done, but unfortunately there were very few spectators in attendance. The Hayes Chapter joined wiht the Gen. James H. McBride Camp #632 SCV and had a table at the Event. Those participating from the Hayes Chapter were; Commander Les Wood with his wife Pam and sons Darrell, Charlie, and Zack, and Adjutant Rick Perry. Joining Commander Wood and Adjutant Perry, who are also Members of the McBride Camp, were McBride Camp Commander Mark Harris and Lt. Commander Garry Lisenby.
